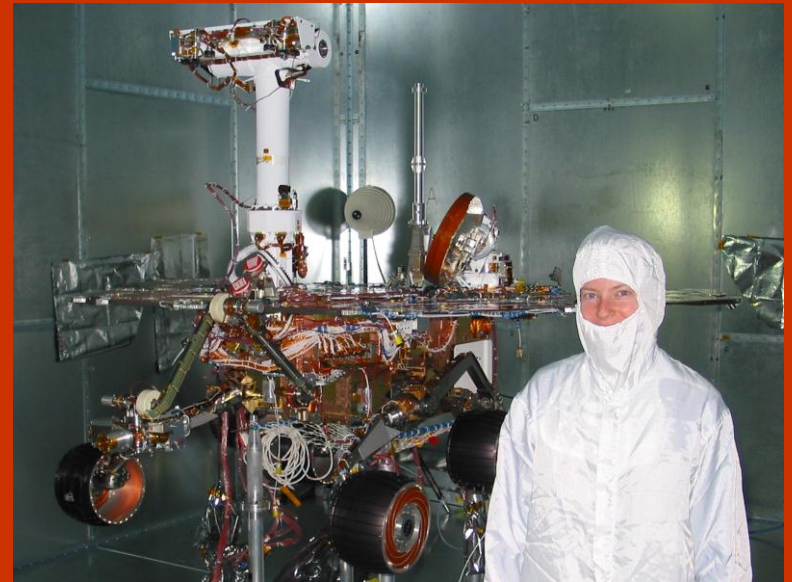
There is a fee of \$15.00 to cover the cost of materials. For students on free and reduce price lunch, the fee is waived.
